



Military Navigator Representative Training Pre-Requisites - 2.0 – March 2013

The following assessment determines if a person meets the prerequisites to enter Navigator Representative (NR) Training. That is, to become a Navigator Intern (NI). Not meeting these prerequisites does not disqualify an individual for Navigator Representative Training. It simply means more training is necessary before formal Navigator Training begins. The Military Navigators view these training outcomes as the natural result of laborer training that most, but not all, Insiders will receive in local ministries.
